SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2020

Beginning in 1987, the Women's Executive Council has granted scholarships to deserving women who are entering or attending colleges in the Central Florida area.

This year the Women's Executive Council will be awarding scholarships of \$1,972 each. The \$1,972 scholarship commemorates the founding year of WEC – 1972.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must be registered for at least 12 hours at the University of Central Florida, Rollins College (including the Hamilton Holt School evening division), Valencia College, Seminole State College, Florida Institute of Technology. High School students must be a Senior and registered to attend one of the above stated Colleges/Universities for Summer or Fall 2020.
- The applicant must have at least a 3.2 GPA pursuing an Undergraduate, Master's, or Doctorate Degree. Applications will not be considered without a transcript (official or unofficial) e-mailed directly to WEC scholarships@wecOrlando.com (as a PDF with the school contact information listed). An unofficial high school transcript is required if the applicant is entering college for the first time.
- The application and all attachments must be received by the WEC Scholarship Committee by the deadline noted below to be considered.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- Application and all attachments must be e-mailed by end of the business: **May 31, 2020**.
- Notification of award selection **July 1, 2020**. ***ONLY Winners will be notified and listed on our website. Please be prepared to submit a short biography and high-resolution professional photo by July 15, 2020 if you are selected.***

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IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

IN ORDER FOR YOUR APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED, THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED:

The application, resume, essay, two (2) letters of recommendation, a transcript (official or unofficial) from your school and the application must all be received together. **If any document is missing, your application will not be considered.**

Resume:

- Resume must include the following, in order; Education, Work, Community Involvement, Activities, Honors/Achievements.

Essay - Please provide answers to the following:

- Please explain why you should be awarded a Women's Executive Council scholarship. Let us know what difference the scholarship would make to you in the pursuit of your educational, and professional goals. Include your financial hardship and any obstacles that you had to overcome in the pursuit of your academic endeavors.
- Include what your interests are academically and professionally once you complete your course of study.
- Please double-space your essay. Your total essay response should be a minimum of 500 words and not to exceed 750 words.

Letters of Recommendation:

- Letters should come from someone who knows you and your school/work ethics. A professor, employer, teacher, guidance counselor, coach, or long-term family friend should write the recommendation. The letters of recommendation should contain how the writer knows you, for how long they have known you, and why they believe you are deserving of the scholarship.

Formatting and Attaching Documents:

- Application, resume, essay, two (2) letters of recommendation, and transcript, must be attached to a single email and emailed to scholarships@wecOrlando.com by **5 pm on May 31, 2020.**
- The applicant's name and school must be in the subject line (Mary Smith/Valencia College) of the email.
- The Application, Resume, Essay, and Letters of Recommendation must be named with the applicant's name and document name (Mary Smith Application, Mary Smith Resume, Mary Smith Essay, Mary Smith Letter of Recommendation #1, Mary Smith Letter of Recommendation #2, etc.)
